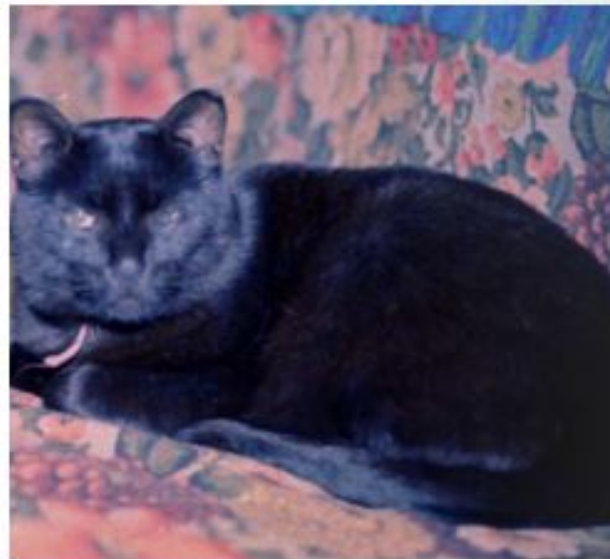




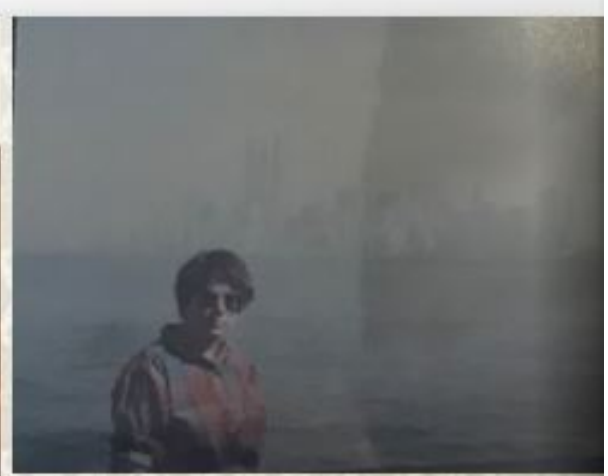

Once again I want to wish u guys a HAPPY 30th ANNIVERSARY! Ur family will always have a special place in my heart!

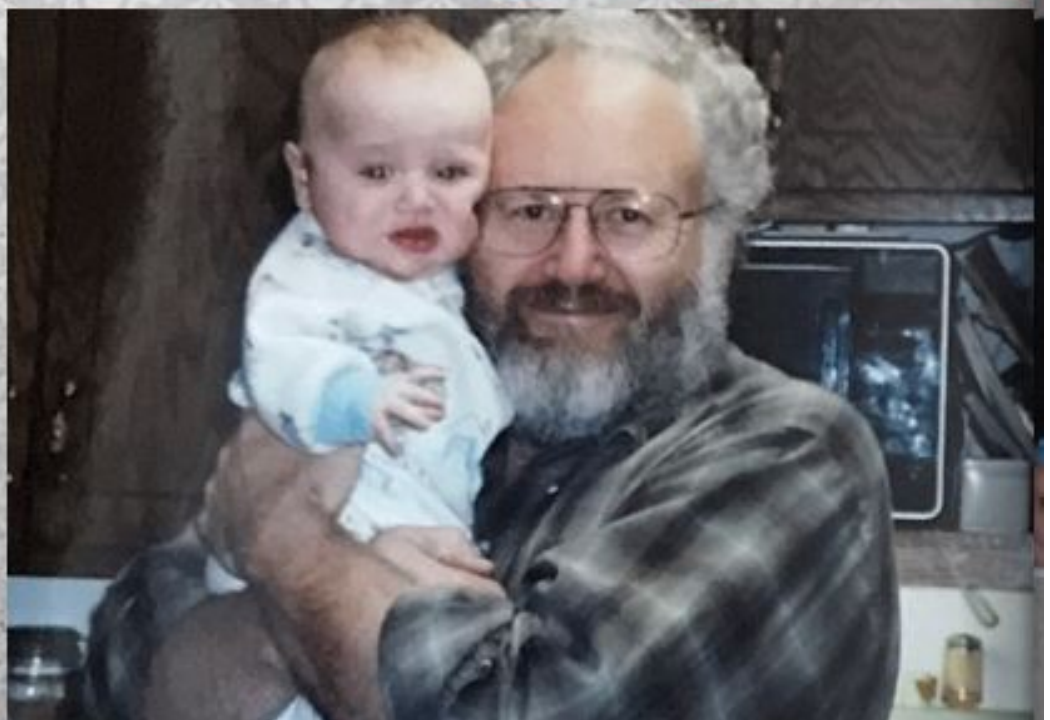
